

Gordon Stewart: An exploration of Phonetics in French Song and a Masterclass

Distinguished musician and linguist, Gordon Stewart, who is a senior vocal coach at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, will inform, refresh and guide us through the nuances of the phonetics shaping the pronunciation in French Song and then give a masterclass to three young, rising singers.

Gordon studied French and German at King's College, Cambridge and took a London University BMus while studying piano and voice at the Royal College of Music. Since then he's worked in various fields of music, as a performer, teacher, vocal coach, producer on Radio 3, broadcaster, adjudicator, writer, translator, commentator and reviewer -even, on occasions, as a conductor. He has taught at the major London music colleges, and was for five years Head of Voice at the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama, (as it then was).
